Lesson 1 - Greetings

We use greetings whenever we meet someone and before starting a conversation with them. We also use greetings when we take leave from them, i.e. after a conversation when we want to say 'bye.'

Salut = Hello (सॅल्यू)

There are a few different ways to say hello **informally**. Let's have a look at them.

- 1) *Salut*(सॅल्यू)
- 2) *Coucou* (कुकू) = This expression is mainly used with friends and family.

There are a few different ways of saying hello **formally**. Let's have a look at them.

- 1) *Bonjour* (बोंजूर) = Hello / Good morning / Good Afternoon / Good Day. This greeting can be used anytime throughout the day.
- 2) *Bonsoir* (बोंस्वार) = Good Evening.

We also use greetings when we take a leave from someone or when we say bye to them.
Informal ways of saying 'bye':

- 1) *Ciao* (चाओ)= Goodbye.
- 2) *À bientôt* (आ बियांतो)= See you soon.
- 3) *À demain* (आ दमा)= See you tomorrow.
- 4) *Bonne nuit* (बोन न्युई)= Good Night. This expression can be used before going to bed.

Formal ways of saying 'bye':

- 1) *Au revoir* (ओ रव्हुआर)= Goodbye
- 2) *Bonne nuit* (बोन न्युई)= Good Night. This expression can be used before going to bed.

Lesson 2 – Days of the Week

The French days of the week are called

'Les jours de la semaine' (ले जूर द ला समेन)

- **Monday** = *Lundi*. लन्दी.
- **Tuesday** = *Mardi*. मारी.
- **Wednesday** = *Mercredi*. मेक्रेदी.
- **Thursday** = *Jeudi*. जदी.
- **Friday** = *Vendredi*. व्हॉद्रदी.
- **Saturday** = *Samedi*. साम्दी.
- **Sunday** = *Dimanche*. दिमॉश.

*Saturday and Sunday form '**Le week-end**' which means *the weekend*.

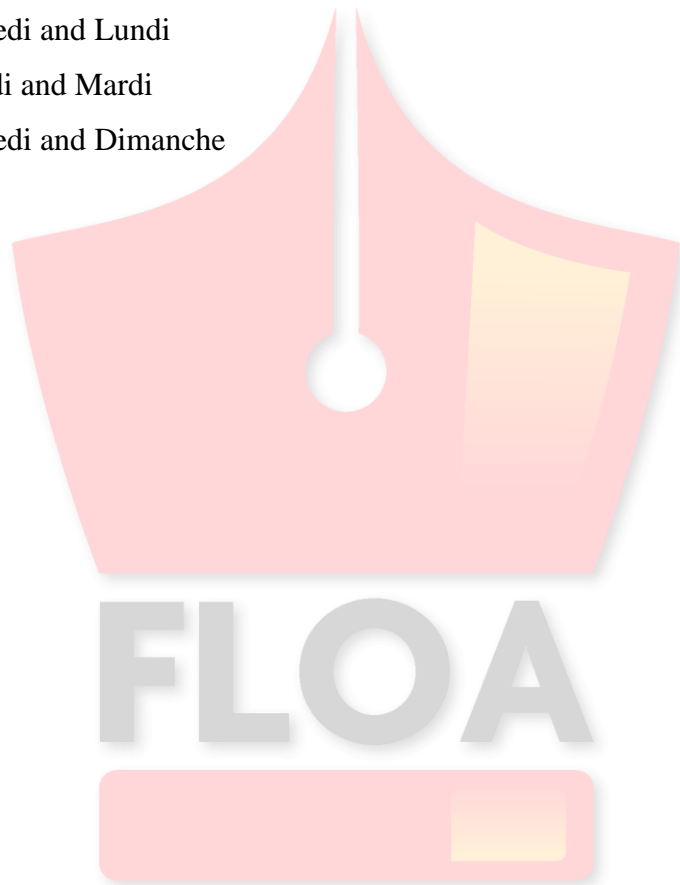

- *Novembre* (नोव्हॉम्ब्र) — November
- *Décembre* (देसॉम्ब्र) — December
