Lesson 1 - Greetings

We use greetings whenever we meet someone and before starting a conversation with them' we greet them. We also use greetings when we take leave from them' i.e. after a conversation when we want to say 'bye.'

Buenos Días = is a formal way of saying hello

Hola	Informal ways of saying 'Hello'
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Are a few different ways of saying hello **formally** . Let's have a look at them.

- 1) **Buenos Días** = Good Morning / Good Day
- 2) **Buenas Tardes** = Good Afternoon / Good Evening. This greeting can be used anytime throughout the day.
- 3) **Buenas Noches** = Good Night.

We also use greetings when we take a leave from someone or when we say bye to them.
Informal ways of saying 'bye':

Ciao – Bye.

Formal ways of saying 'bye':

- 1) Adiós – Goodbye
- 2) Hasta Luego - See you later.
- 3) Hasta Pronto – See you soon.

Lesson 2 – Days of the Week

The Spanish days of the week are called

'Días de la Semana'

- **Monday** = Lunes
- **Tuesday** = Martes
- **Wednesday** = Miércoles
- **Thursday** = Jueves
- **Friday** = Viernes
- **Saturday** = Sábado
- **Sunday** = Domingo

*Saturday and Sunday form 'El fin de semana' which means *the weekend*.

Spring	Primavera	Marzo' Abril' Mayo
